On October 12, 2018, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Southeast District Office (SEDO) received a document titled *Statistical Analysis Program for Groundwater Monitoring (Revision 9)*. The document was submitted in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) by Eagon & Associates, Inc., on behalf of Waste Management, and requested to update the background dataset representing the background water quality at monitoring wells P-106C and MW-11C. This request was made for the Suburban Landfill (Facility) located at 3415 Township Road 447 in Glenford, Perry County, Ohio.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to the current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the director.

Waste Management has met the requirement for including a minimum of four (4) data points for all constituents and monitoring wells during the observation period. As part of the complete data set, Waste Management is requesting to update the background observation period with three data points that were noted to be statistically significant increases, which require approval from the Director.

Waste Management has proposed using the following statistically significant data from monitoring wells P-106C and MW-11C as part of the Facility's background data:

P-106C	Arsenic	4.6 ug/L	3/2018
MW-11C	Zinc	14 ug/L	9/2016

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
Ohio EPA has reviewed the applicable information and concurs with the addition of the above data to existing background data. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the owner or operator is hereby authorized to incorporate the above data in the Facility's background data.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
