On January 3, 2019, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a request, dated December 26, 2018, titled "*Request for Alternate Groundwater Monitoring Frequency for the Wapakoneta Landfill*". The document was submitted in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E)(8) [as effective March 1, 1990] by Hull & Associates, Inc., on behalf of the City of Wapakoneta, and requested to reduce the required frequency for ground water monitoring during ground water quality assessment from quarterly to semi-annually at Wapakoneta Closed Landfill (Facility) located at 510 North Water Street, Wapakoneta, Ohio.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E)(8) [as effective March 1, 1990], the owner/operator is required to perform ground water monitoring for the assessment monitoring program on a quarterly basis unless the Director establishes an alternate frequency for ground water monitoring.

I have reviewed the applicable information and hereby approve an alternate frequency of semi-annually for ground water monitoring for monitoring wells in the ground water quality assessment program. The Facility shall continue monitoring any wells not part of the ground water quality assessment program in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10, unless otherwise authorized by Ohio EPA.


You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action.

The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
