Dear Mr. Adkins:

Liberty Tire Pilot (Facility) is located at 14864 Lincoln S.E., Minerva, Stark County and is currently owned by Liberty Tire Services of Ohio, LLC. Waste disposal operations at the Facility ceased in 2008 and closure was finalized on March 20, 2009. As a pilot scrap tire monofill landfill, the applicable post-closure care period is 10 years, in accordance with the Director's Final Findings and Orders (DFF&Os) issued on March 20, 1995. Therefore, the post-closure care period for the Facility ended on March 20, 2019.

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that, consistent with written notification from Liberty Tire Services of Ohio, LLC, the post-closure care period for the Facility as defined by the March 20, 1995, DFF&Os has ceased. Please be advised that environmental laws are still applicable to the Facility, in particular Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 6111 which prohibits pollution to waters of the state.


You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
