On February 19, 2019, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a document, dated February 18, 2019, titled "Statistical Analysis Program [Plan] for Ground Water Quality Monitoring (Revision 13)". The document included a request in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) by Eagon and Associates, Inc., on behalf of Republic Services (Owner), and requested to update the background data group representing the background water quality at monitoring wells SW-11 for chromium (5.1 and 5.3 ug/L), RW-11 for chromium (2.1 ug/L), and RW-12 for potassium (five data points ranging in concentration from 4.3 to 5.1 mg/L) and sodium (31 and 33 mg/L) at County Environmental Landfill of Wyandot (Facility) located at 11164 County Highway 4, Carey, Ohio, Wyandot County. Ohio EPA's review of the Statistical Plan portion of the submittal will be documented in a separate letter.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to the current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the director.

Ohio EPA concurs with the request to determine if the alternative method of evaluation adequately demonstrates, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(B)(1)(a), (C)(4), and (C)(5), that the data represents the quality of background ground water that has not been affected by past or present operations at the sanitary landfill facility. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the owner or operator is hereby authorized to update the background database for monitoring wells SW-11 for chromium, RW-11 for chromium, and RW-12 for potassium and sodium to include the data in the table below.



You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
