On February 19, 2019, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a document titled "*Corrective Measures Study – Revision 4*" (cover letter dated February 13, 2019), which was submitted by Eagon & Associates, Inc. on behalf of Waste Management. The document was submitted in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F) [as effective March 1, 1990] and Order No. 5 of the October 31, 2011 Director's Final Findings and Orders and requests approval of the Corrective Measures Study – Revision 4, which includes a contingency remedy for the ground water quality of sodium sulfate injection into three gas vents as part of the corrective measures program for the Sheriff Road Closed Landfill (Facility), located at 1136 Sheriff Road, Lima, Ohio.

I have reviewed the applicable information and hereby approve the Corrective Measures Study - Revision 4, including the contingency remedy of sodium sulfate injection into three gas vents as part of the corrective measures program.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio


