On May 15, 2019, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a revised document titled "*Corrective Measures Plan*" (dated May 2019 and cover letter dated May 14, 2019), which was submitted by The Mannik & Smith Group, Inc. on behalf of the Ashland County Commissioners. The plan was submitted in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F) and documents a proposed remedy of continued ground water monitoring with operation of the passive gas extraction system and maintenance of the landfill cap for the Ashland County Closed Landfill, (Facility), located at County Road 1754, Ashland, Ohio.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F)(10), the director shall select from the corrective measures plan, or designate according to paragraph (F)(6) of this rule, the corrective measure which best meets the criteria listed in paragraphs (F)(2), (F)(3), and (F)(7) of this rule. I have reviewed the applicable information and hereby approve the Corrective Measures Plan (dated May 2019), including the remedy of continued ground water monitoring with operation of the passive gas extraction system and maintenance of the landfill cap.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that

payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
