Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(4) Approval**

Dear Mr. Palmer:

On June 27, 2019, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northeast District Office (NEDO) received a request, dated June 24, 2019, titled "Request for Director's Approval per OAC 3745-27-10(D)(4)." The document was submitted in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(4) by Waste Management (Owner) for American Landfill (Facility). The submitted request was prepared by Eagon & Associates, Inc. The Owner requests approval of an alternative parameter list for low-yielding Lower Kittanning Coal (LKC)/Mine Spoil Significant Zone of Saturation (SZS) detection well LKC-2A at the Facility located at 7916 Chapel Street SE, Waynesburg, Ohio, in Stark County.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(4), the owner or operator may propose in writing, that an alternative list of any of the appendix I monitoring wells not screened in the uppermost aquifer system that cannot produce enough water within a twenty-four hour period to allow for the analysis of all of the required parameters. Upon approval by the Director or her authorized representative, the owner or operator may use the alternative parameter list.

The requested alternative parameter list for LKC/Mine Spoil SZS monitoring well LKC-2A contains all of the OAC Rule 3745-27-10 Appendix I Parameters except 1,2-dibromo-3-chloropropane (DBCP) and 1,2-dibromoethane (EDB) (which have previously been deleted with Director's approval); however, the sampling order for this well has been re-prioritized and specific parameters sampled/tested for during a given sampling event would be limited to those on the list for which there is the adequate sample volume required by the laboratory within a 24 hour-period from initializing sampling. Well LKC-2A is sampled utilizing minimal purge methods.

I have reviewed the applicable information and approve alternative ground water list for monitoring at the Facility. The Facility shall continue monitoring all other detection wells in the monitoring system for the required parameters listed in Appendix I (except DBCP and EDP which have previously been deleted by the Director) in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10, unless otherwise authorized by Ohio EPA.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
