Dear Mr. Gregg:

On February 5, 2020, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received the revised Corrective Measures Study, dated February 2020 (previous versions dated May 2019 and October 2019), which was submitted by Hull & Associates, Inc. on behalf of the City of Wapakoneta. The plan was submitted in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F)(6), as effective March 1, 1990, and documents a proposed remedy of source control and monitored natural attenuation for the Wapakoneta Landfill, (Facility), located at 510 North Water Street, Wapakoneta, Ohio.

OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F)(6) [effective March 1, 1990] indicates that the Director shall select from the corrective measures report the corrective measure which best meets the criteria listed in OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F)(1), (F)(2) and (F)(5).

I have reviewed the applicable information, and pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F)(6), as effective March 1, 1990, I hereby approve the Corrective Measures Study dated February 2020, including the remedy of source control and monitored natural attenuation. Source control at the Facility includes leachate management and will be augmented by landfill cap maintenance, explosive gas management and surface water and storm water management.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing

of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
