Alternate Ground Water Monitoring Parameter List Request - Approval**

Dear Mr. Ardner:

On July 16, 2020, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a document titled "*Request for Removing EDB and DBCP from the Groundwater Monitoring Parameter List for the Active Industrial Solid Waste Landfill,*" dated July 16, 2020, from Materion Brush Inc. (Materion). The submittal documents Materion's request for approval of an alternate ground water monitoring parameter list in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-30-08(D)(2) for the Active Industrial Waste Landfill (Facility), located at 14710 West Portage River South Road, Elmore, Ohio.

OAC Rule 3745-30-08(D)(2) states that owners of industrial waste landfills may propose an alternate list of ground water monitoring parameters for approval and that the alternate list shall be indicative of the waste stream deposited in the landfill facility and shall be protective of human health and safety and the environment.

The submittal documents that 1,2-Dibromoethane (EDB) and 1,2-Dibromo-3-chloropropane (DBCP) have never been used at the Facility and documents that these constituents have not been detected in the Facility's leachate or ground water.

I have reviewed the alternate ground water monitoring parameter list request dated July 16, 2020 and applicable information and hereby approve the request to delete EDB and DBCP from the required ground water monitoring parameter list for the facility.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission

within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
