Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-30-08(C)(6)(g) Approval**

Dear Mr. Kolesar:

On May 29, 2020, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northeast District Office (NEDO) received a document titled "2020 GCMP Background Statistical Database Update" dated May 28, 2020, for the ArcelorMittal Cleveland Area B Landfill (Facility) ground water compliance monitoring program. This document was prepared by Burgess & Niple, Inc. on behalf of ArcelorMittal Cleveland, LLC (Owner) and requested that an identified outlier be allowed to remain in its existing background dataset at the Facility.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-30-08(C)(6)(g), background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to the current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the director.

The Owner identified one outlier and provided justification for retaining it in its respective dataset. The result for cis-1,2-Dichloroethene (3.1 µg/L) collected on June 12, 2019 from monitoring well MW-66S was identified as an outlier.


Ohio EPA has reviewed the May 28, 2020 document and concurs with the request to retain the identified outlier in its existing background dataset. Ohio EPA's review determined that the Owner has provided sufficient justification to retain the identified outlier, cis-1,2-Dichloroethene (3.1 µg/L) from well MW-66S collected on June 12, 2019, in its existing background dataset and that the document meets the requirements of OAC 3745-30-08(C)(6)(g). Therefore, Ohio EPA approves ArcelorMittal Cleveland, LLC's request pursuant to OAC 3745-30-08(C)(6)(g) at the Area B Landfill as presented in the Ground Water Compliance Monitoring Program.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
