Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(2) Approval**

Dear Commissioner, Ohler:

On June 30, 2020, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northeast District Office (NEDO) received a request, dated June 29, 2020, titled "*Variance Request Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-03(C) from Groundwater Quality Assessment Monitoring Requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E) and Demonstration Pursuant to OAC 3745-27-10(F)(8) Carroll County Landfill – Carroll County, Ohio.*" The document also contains a request in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(2) to remove 1,2-Dibromo-3-chloropropane (DBCP) and 1,2-Dibromoethane (EDB) from the list of Appendix I ground water monitoring parameters to be analyzed in monitoring wells in the Detection Monitoring Program at Carroll County Landfill (Facility). The document was submitted by Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc., on behalf of the Carroll County Commissioners. Carroll County Landfill is located on Chase Road in Center Township, Carrollton, Ohio.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(2), the owner or operator of a sanitary Landfill facility may propose in writing to delete any of the Appendix I parameters monitored to meet the requirements of paragraphs (D)(5) to (D)(7) of OAC Rule 3745-27-10. The Director of Environmental Protection may approve an alternative list of monitoring parameters if the removed parameters are not reasonably expected to be in or derived from the waste contained or deposited in the sanitary landfill facility. Upon approval, the owner or operator may use the alternative list.


I have reviewed the applicable information and approve the alternative list removing DBCP and EDB from further ground water monitoring at the Facility in the Detection Monitoring Program. The Facility shall continue monitoring all wells in the monitoring system for the remaining parameters listed in Appendix I in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10, unless otherwise authorized by Ohio EPA.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
