Dear Austin Brewer:

On March 2, 2023, Ohio EPA received a request for a Class 1A (Class 1 requiring prior approval) hazardous waste permit modification from SES-R1 dba Resource One LLC dated March 1, 2023. The modification requested the following change to the permit:

Revised the permit compliance schedule in Permit Condition G.12 for submittal of as-built drawings from 165 days to 225 days after permit issuance.

With this letter, Ohio EPA approves the above referenced Class 1A modification¹ submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-50-51, and accordingly has updated the facility's permit application and/or permit. The updated application/permit can be retrieved from the Agency's eDocument Search web site: <http://edocpub.epa.ohio.gov/publicportal/edochome.aspx>. Using the search function, search under the document type of "Permit" and then refine the search using the facility's RCRA ID number (Secondary ID) which is noted in the RE: block above.

At closure of the Miscellaneous Units, the Permittee shall follow the procedures in Appendix H of the approved permit application in accordance with OAC Rules 3745-55-10 through 3745-55-40.

G.12 Compliance Schedule

The Permittee must provide the following information to the Director.

Item	Date Due to the Director
A certificate of installation for new miscellaneous units, signed and stamped by a registered professional engineer, per OAC Rule 3745-50-58(L)(2)	Within sixty (60) days after final permit issuance.
As-built drawing for any miscellaneous units currently in use, stamped by a registered professional engineer, per OAC Rule 3745-50-58(L)(2)	Within two hundred and twenty-five (225) days after final permit issuance.
