**Subject: Second Ninety (90)-Day Extension to the February 11, 2015 Emergency Order pursuant to ORC 6109.05(B)**

Dear Mr. Daley:

I am writing with regard to the Emergency Order ("Order") issued to you on February 11, 2015, which went into effect immediately for a period of ninety (90) days. The first extension to this Order was issued on May 11, 2015 for an additional ninety (90) days. The Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation regarding the first extension was issued on June 9, 2015. On June 19, 2015, the Staff of Ohio EPA ("Staff") filed Objections to the Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation. On July 10, 2015, your attorney filed a Motion to Strike Objections. On July 17, 2015, Staff filed a Memorandum Contra to the Motion to Strike Objections and your attorney filed a Reply In Support of his Motion to Strike Objections. A final action regarding the first extension has not been issued as of the date of this letter.

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 6109.05(B), I am extending the effectiveness of the Emergency Order for an additional ninety (90) days from the effective date of this letter because the emergency condition identified in the Emergency Order still exists.

In accordance with ORC 6109.05(B) and OAC 3745-47-19, you may request a hearing within ten days after receipt of this order. If a hearing is requested in accordance with ORC 6109.05(B) and OAC 3745-47-19, the hearing will be held within forty-eight hours to consider the issues raised by the adjudication hearing request. If necessary to obtain necessary evidence, the hearing examiner may continue the adjudication hearing, but shall reconvene the adjudication hearing as soon as possible and not later than 20 days. At an adjudication hearing you may appear in person, or be represented by your attorney, or by such representative as is permitted to practice before this Agency, or you may present your position, arguments, or contentions in writing. At the hearing you may present evidence and examine witnesses appearing against you. The request for a hearing shall be in writing and shall specify the issues of fact and law to be contested. Requests for a hearing shall be submitted in writing to the Hearing Clerk, Ohio EPA, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049.
