Dear Mr. Boland:

On August 18, 2015, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Southeast District Office (SEDO) received a three volume document titled "City of Steubenville Landfill, Closure Plan" for the City of Steubenville Landfill (Facility). This document was submitted by Bennett & Williams Environmental Consultants, Inc. on behalf of the City of Steubenville and in response to the Amended Agreed Order for Judgment (Agreed Order), filed March 13, 2013 in the Court of Common Pleas, Jefferson County, which required the preparation and submission of design plans and technical specifications for capping the Facility. In accordance with the Agreed Order, the plan sheets were to be prepared in accordance with the applicable paragraphs of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-11(B)(1) to (B)(10), and the technical specifications were to be prepared as prescribed within Exhibit A of the Agreed Order, titled "Landfill Capping".

Ohio EPA has reviewed the Closure Plan and has determined that the design plans were prepared in accordance with the applicable rules and that the technical specifications were prepared in accordance with the Agreed Order.

Therefore, I hereby approve the "City of Steubenville Landfill, Closure Plan" received by Ohio EPA on August 18, 2015.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is



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based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
