Dear Commissioners:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-27-02 and the rules adopted thereunder, has reviewed the application for a permit with accompanying detail plans, specifications and/or information (hereinafter referred to as "application") regarding the above-referenced facility. This application has been approved by the Director subject to the conditions of compliance contained in the permit approval enclosed herewith and with all applicable laws, rules and standards. All construction must be supervised by an engineer or expert qualified in such work. Because the permit approval contains conditions of compliance, I urge you to read it carefully.

You are requested to submit within thirty (30) days of the date of issuance of this Permit to Install, the required permit fee balance of six hundred dollars (\$1,000.00 - \$400.00 application fee = \$600.00), payable to **Treasurer, State of Ohio**. Please send the required payment to:

Payment of the \$600.00 fee within 30 days is a requirement of ORC Sections 3745.11 (Q) and (V). Failure to timely submit the required permit fee will result in an assessment of late penalties.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth

the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. 

Issuance of this permit approval does not constitute expressed or implied approval or agreement that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with the plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will operate in compliance with applicable state and federal laws, rules, and regulations, and does not constitute expressed or implied assurances that if constructed and/or modified in accordance with those plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will be granted the necessary operating permits and/or licenses. This permit approval is issued subject to the attached conditions which are hereby incorporated and made a part hereof.

PERMIT SUMMARY

This permit approval (PTI Number 1056181) for Erie County Sanitary Landfill (Facility) authorizes an increase in the Facility's authorized maximum daily waste receipt (AMDWR) from 800 tons to 1,200 tons. The previous AMDWR was established by PTI Number 03-18534, issued June 10, 2013.

Although this PTI increases the AMDWR to 1,200 tons, because the Facility is limited to the same maximum annual waste acceptance limit, the life of the Facility will remain the same at approximately 18 years. Based on the facility's average anticipated daily gate receipt of about 440 tons, the estimated life of the facility will be approximately 32 years.

The above summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached permit-to-install.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The director, or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named permittee at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (municipal solid waste disposal facility).
2. The Facility's AMDWR is hereby established to be 1,200 tons. This supersedes any previously established AMDWR for the Facility.
3. This approval shall apply only to the increase in the Facility's AMDWR as requested in the application submitted for this permit, received September 22, 2015.
4. The permittee shall not accept more than 1,200 tons of solid waste per day. Each calendar month, the total waste, including solid waste and other wastes received, shall not exceed 20,067 tons.
5. Issuance of this permit approval does not relieve the permittee of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
6. This permit approval may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this municipal solid waste disposal facility.

7. The permittee shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the municipal solid waste disposal facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
8. Nothing in this permit approval shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit approval shall not be interpreted to release the permittee from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
9. This permit approval does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except for those excluded from hazardous or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
10. This permit approval does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M. No such asbestos-containing waste material may be accepted without first obtaining the necessary permits from Ohio EPA.
11. The permittee shall comply with the requirements of all previously-issued authorizing documents for the Facility, except, to the extent that this permit approval specifies requirements different from or in addition to the requirements of those previously-issued authorizing documents for the Facility, the permittee shall comply with this permit. This permit, and the terms and conditions contained herein, shall take precedence over any conflicting requirements.
