Dear Mr. Ramey:

On May 12, 2016, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) received your request to obtain authorization to transport scrap tires currently open dumped on your property without obtaining a scrap tire transporter registration. In a letter dated March 31, 2016, you were cited in violation of open dumping of scrap tires at your property located at 15284 Old McArthur Rd., Logan, Hocking County, Ohio.

OAC Rule 3745-27-54(A)(2)(m) states, in relevant part, that a person may transport scrap tires without obtaining a scrap tire transporter registration if the director specifically authorizes that person, in writing, to transport their scrap tires in order to remove scrap tires from a property to abate a public nuisance or open dump.


In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-54(A)(2)(m), I hereby authorize Steve Ramey to transport scrap tires from 15284 Old McArthur Rd. to Liberty Scrap Tire (licensed scrap tire facility) located at 3041 Jackson Pike, Grove City, Ohio 43123, as well as Campbell Scrap Tire (licensed scrap tire facility) located at 2485 Maysville Pike, Zanesville, Ohio 43701. You are directed to remove and dispose of the scrap tires present on your property. Please be advised that only Steve Ramey of 15284 Old McArthur Rd., Logan, Ohio 43138 or his designee is authorized to transport the scrap tires under this authorization and may only use vehicles owned or leased by Steve Ramey. This authorization shall expire on September 30, 2016, or at the time the scrap tire cleanup is complete, whichever occurs first. Please be advised that you must comply with the shipping paper requirements outlined in OAC Rule 3745-27-57. Please place a copy of this letter in any vehicle used for the transportation of scrap tires, as authorized by this letter.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
