Dear Commissioners:

On October 21, 2016, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a request, dated October 21, 2016, titled *Defiance County Landfill (MSWL#018764) Statistical Analysis Program for Groundwater Monitoring – Revision 8*. The document was submitted in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) by Eagon & Associates, Inc., on behalf of the Defiance County Commissioners (Owner), and requested to update the background data group representing the background water quality at monitoring wells MW-8A, MW-11 and P-11S at the Defiance County Landfill (Facility) located at 13207 Canal Road, Defiance, Defiance County, Ohio. Ohio EPA initially responded January 27, 2017. However, our response letter included a clerical error. This letter corrects the error and replaces the January 27, 2017, response.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to the current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the director.

The Defiance County Commissioners have proposed using the following statistically significant data from wells MW-8A, MW-11 and P-11S as part of the Facility's background data.

- MW-8A; ammonia
- P-11S; chloride
- MW-11; ammonia

Ohio EPA has reviewed the applicable information and concurs with the addition of the above data to existing background data. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the owner or operator is hereby authorized to incorporate the above data in the Facility's background data.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
