# A Narrative Description of the Village of Granville, Ohio Water Distribution System, in regards to lead service lines


- The Village of Granville currently has 1670 service connections of various sizes from ¾" to 8" diameter.
- There are no known lead service lines in the Village of Granville's Water Distribution System, not on the Village's side (corp. stop to curb stop) or the customer's side of the service line(curb stop to building).
- Customer service lines on the Village's side are either galvanized iron, K-copper, cast iron, ductile iron, or C900 PVC.
- Customer service lines on the Customer's side are either galvanized iron, K-copper, plastic (200 psi) tubing, cast iron, ductile iron, or C900 PVC.
- No lead piping is known to exist in the Village of Granville's Water Distribution System.
- Customers served by Granville's Distribution System are identified on the map of the distribution system.
- Customers with buildings built before 1998 are color-coded brown and are the most likely to have leaded solder or plumbing fixtures containing lead.
- Customers with buildings built between 1998 and 2014 are color coded red and are less likely to have lead solder or plumbing fixtures containing lead than houses built before 1998.
- Customer with buildings built after 2014 are color coded blue and are least likely to have leaded solder or plumbing fixtures containing lead.

#### **EPA Mapping - North Central Area**









#### **EPA Mapping - Northern Area**










### **EPA Mapping - South Central Area**










## **EPA Mapping - Southeastern Area**







