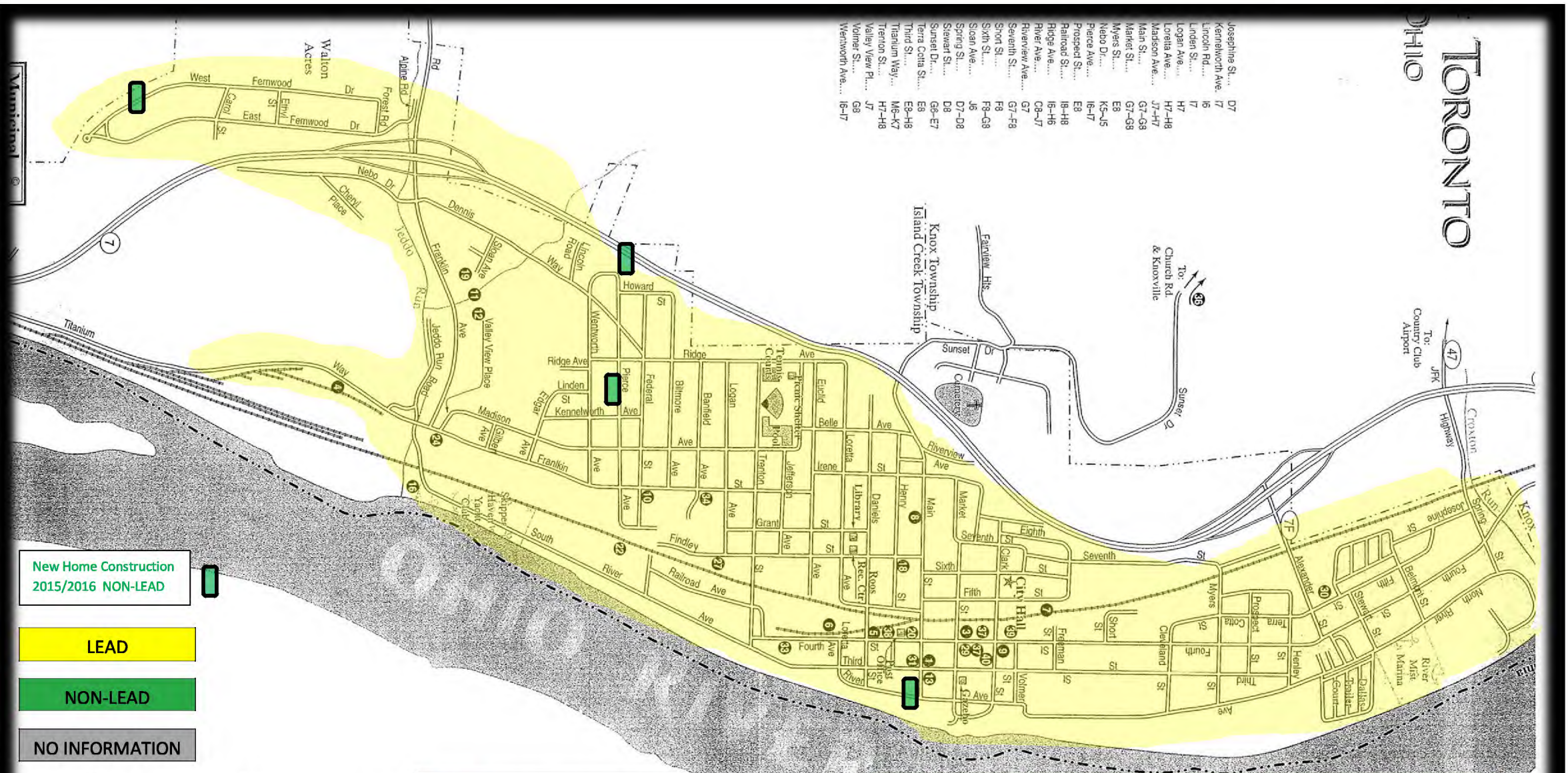


DISTRIBUTION AREAS SHADED IN YELLOW MAY HAVE POTENTIAL LEAD MATERIAL CONTENTS EITHER IN THE SERVICE TO THE RESIDENCE, HOME PLUMBING OR FIXTURES.



Section 36. Service connections in the streets are the responsibility of the property owner. All service connections between the city main and the property, including the curb stop must be installed by a licensed plumber or contractor. The water department is responsible for the main lines and corporation only within the City's distribution system. Reasonable notification by the water superintendent will be final.

"Buildings in Toronto Ohio built prior to 1998 or that use plumbing material or solder manufactured before 1998 may have materials with greater than 8% lead and are at a higher risk of contributing lead to the drinking water than materials manufactured after 1998. In addition, buildings built and plumbing materials manufactured after 2014 were required to have less than 0.25% lead by weight and have the lowest risk for contributing lead to the drinking water. It should be noted however that, although prohibited, some use of leaded solder or leaded components may have occurred after the prohibitions became effective."
