The Village of Gambier March 2017 Lead Mapping

The Village of Gambier sent out a survey to all Gambier Residents on January 27, 2017, to date we have gotten approximately 50% returned. The Village also used the documentation we had from water leak repairs and pit meter installations over the last 20 years. We will continue to document information has we receive it and update the data and mapping. At the time of submitting our information we have indentified 3 lead service lines in the Village of Gambier.

The Village of Gambier had one of our Maintenance Employees and Kenyon College Plumber conducted surveys of all Kenyon owned buildings at the end of January and early February. No lead service lines or plumbing inside the buildings were identified.

The Village of Gambier is providing a spreadsheet with all current data.

The Village of Gambier water System is made of plastic and ductile iron main line pipes. The Village of Gambier service lines are made up of plastic and copper.

Gambier Resident service lines are made up of plastic, copper, galvanized steel and 3 lead customer side service lines have been identified.
