The Village of Millersport's original public water system was built in 1968.

#### Water Distribution System

The original water distribution system was cement asbestos (AC) pipe for all water main lines larger than 2 inches. The 2 inch and 3 inch water main lines are PVC plastic.

In 1982, there were 2 main water line extensions which serve out of town customers. Both of these main water line extensions are PVC plastic.

Water service lines are high density polyethylene (HDPE) for the following sizes; ¾ inches, 1 inch, 1½ inch, and 2 inch. However, there are some 2 inch PVC plastic water service lines. Larger than 2 inch water service lines are PVC plastic. THERE ARE NO LEAD WATER SERVICE LINES IN OUR WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.

### Identifying Characteristics of Building Plumbing

We have an elementary school, middle/high school, doctors office, dentist office, 3 churches, post office, one gas station, several restaurants, 3 boat marinas, bank, pharmacy, hardware, rope manufacturing business, boat lift manufacturer, bolt and screw packaging business, along with several small business's. From previous service calls, the above facilities are predominately copper plumbing.

Residential plumbing is predominately copper plumbing, with PVC plastic plumbing being used second. New repairs and modifications to household plumbing have been changing to the easier to use plastic PEX pipe and plumbing fittings which are available in plastic and non-lead brass.

# VERIFICATION FORM FOR COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS CLAIMING NO LEAD SERVICE LINES
