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Narrative for Lead and Copper Rule

PWS ID OH3300712, Hardin County

All of the buildings within the McGuffey corporation limits are served by the McGuffey Water Department. All water mains in the distribution system are C-900 PVC or Cast Iron (CI), as shown on the distribution map.

The Village replaced all service lines around 1995, installing copper service lines and meter pits to each customer. These new service lines were connected to the customer connection of copper, galvanized or plastic. There is no contractor record of what they were connected to. To my knowledge, no lead service lines were identified during this project.

The Village has no building permits or service line maintenance records. During service work, only copper, galvanized, or plastic pipe has been seen.

The Village of McGuffey has no known lead service lines on private property or on public property connecting to the distribution system.


All of the homes in McGuffey predate 1998. There have been a few mobile homes brought in, but they are all used. The only new structure in McGuffey has been the H-12 school, which was constructed in 2000-2001.

1. Historical Records:

I spoke with the clerk/treasurer Norma Sieg about historical records. The only historical records that she handles are the local resolutions and ordinances. In review these records, there is nothing dealing with lead and copper.

2. Distribution Records:

I spoke with Richard Shirk, town maintenance man, about maintenance records. He stated he only keeps maintenance records for the water plant and sewer plant.

3. Installation Dates:

The only installation dates they keep are actual project dates. The Jones and Henry Engineering firm has designed most of McGuffey's projects and we have requested digital copies of all projects they have done for McGuffey. All service lines were replaced around 1995.

4. Service Line Material:

All service lines are known to be copper since they have all been replaced with a grant project through the Hardin County Regional Planning Commission.

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
