Village of Wayne Public Water System Lead (Pb) Components

Prepared March 2017

To comply with Section 6109.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, enacted in September 2016, the Village of Wayne in Wood County, Ohio has created the following report and attached map to identify known and potential components of its public water system that contain lead (Pb).

Service Lines and Ownership

The Village of Wayne Water Department distributes water to 383 services. The Village owns and maintains service lines from the water distribution mains up to the meters that are located in the Village right-of-way. The remainder of each service line from the meter to the building is the responsibility of the property owner. Joe St. Claire is the Village Administrator and oversees the water system. He has been with the Village for 29 years.

The table below provides information about the possibility of lead service lines and use of leaded plumbing materials to the customers Wayne serves. Each service line's probability rating is based on the water system replacement project completed in 2005, and on the private side, based on the year each structure was built.

Distribution System

The Village replaced its entire water system including the public side of the water service lines in 2005. Documentation of this project is attached. As a result of the project, the Village can speak with great certainity there is no lead within its distribution system. The Village only chlorinates its water, and does not require the use of any corrosion control treatment.



Indoor Plumbing

Buildings in Ohio built prior to 1998 or that use plumbing material or solder manufactured before 1998 may have materials with greater than 8% lead and are at a higher risk of contributing lead to the drinking water than materials manufactured after 1998.

Buildings built and plumbing materials manufactured after 2014 were required to have less than 0.25% lead by weight and have the lowest risk for contributing lead to the drinking water. It should be noted however that, although prohibited, some use of leaded solder or leaded components may have occurred after the prohibitions became effective.

Customer Self-Reporting

The information on this map regarding privately owned service lines is based on the information from the water system staff. Property owners are encouraged to inspect their own service lines entering their buildings if these are in anyway exposed, and notify the Village of Wayne Water Department if they have determined whether or not a lead service line exists. Please contact the Village Administrator by calling 419-575-3568. A representative from the water department will contact you to confirm and update this information for the next map release.



VERIFICATION FORM FOR COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS CLAIMING NO LEAD SERVICE LINES

The owner or operator of all community public water systems must identify and map areas of their distribution system that are known or are likely to contain lead service lines. Systems must submit a copy of the applicable map to the Ohio Department of Health and the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services. Systems must also submit a report to the director containing at least both of the following: (1) The applicable map with narrative, and (2) A list of sampling locations used to collect samples as required by Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 6109.121 and any rules adopted thereunder, including contact information for the owner and occupant of each sampling site.

Should a water system determine no lead service lines exist in their distribution system, they must provide information stating they reviewed, at the minimum, historical permit records and local ordinances, distribution maintenance records and information pertaining to installation dates or materials for all services lines. This information must be verified below.


