

### City of Berea Identification of areas with Lead Service Lines

The City of Berea has been proactive about the removal of lead service lines since the lead and copper rules became effective in 1992. Lead service lines had never been prevalent in Berea. Locations which had them were anomalies and it appears that Berea has never had a material requirement for lead service lines in their building code at any time. There are no areas of the City in which numerous houses or entire streets had lead service lines, nor did a particular builder or area. Baker St. and French St. are the only two streets that had multiple lead lines (city side which have since been replaced.) Therefore, it was an easier task to replace the scattering of lines that existed throughout the City. Today, only 3 structures with lead service lines exist to the best of our knowledge and investigation.

Berea has a relatively accurate record of service line installations known as "tap cards". Two duplicate sets of tap cards exist- 1 set at the service garage (for the water distribution crew) and 1 set at the water plant (for the meter service technicians.) These tap cards originate back to almost the beginning of the water system dating back to the 1920's. They not only contain shut off/curb stop measurements, but also service line material, date of tap install, and size of water main tapped. The tap card file is mostly complete, and only on rare occasions can a card for a property not be located. This system of documentation has been well maintained over the years. These tap cards were reviewed not only back in 1992 but again this past year to look for any possible oversights or omissions.

In addition to the tap cards, there are also meter cards that the billing clerk keeps. The meter cards were also referenced to double check dates of commencement of water service via the public water system. If a tap card was missing the meter cards can be referenced for a possible date of construction, and is another source of valuable information about water service provided to a property.

In researching service line material, all lead lines documented in the Berea water system were installed in the 30's and early 40's. Therefore, records for structures built prior to 1950 were more closely scrutinized for lead services. The City of Berea had a huge housing boom starting at the end of World War II (1945) which continued into the 60's. At the commencement of this housing boom, Berea Building code required all service lines installed to be copper through present day. Prior to this time, brass, galvanized iron, and lead were used as well as copper. The galvanized lines have not held up well with many replacements over the years and the City has begun to proactively replace galvanized service lines with hopes to eliminate them within the next couple of years.

The City of Berea has expanded over the years as the original City was surrounded by farmland and township. After World War II, areas to the west and to the south were converted from open farmland and fields into housing developments. There was farmland to the north but intermixed with older neighborhoods as well. The older original structures in the City of Berea start at the northern corp. limit (which borders City of Cleveland) down thru the center of town, especially South Rocky River Drive area, east of the center of town and the main roads of Prospect St., Sprague Rd. West St., and adjacent streets which were close to the west bank of the Rocky River.

Tacit knowledge also played a large role in further confirming and identifying lead services. The water distribution superintendent who worked in the water system for over 30 years had great knowledge of the system and replaced lead lines proactively. He was onsite for most water breaks and repair work. Other water distribution crew workers have many years and solid knowledge of the system and they were consulted as well.

Another recent benefit which aided in identification of service line material was the Meter Replacement Project during 2016. The City of Berea replaced approximately 4,000 meters between June 2016 and March 2017. The contractor installing these meters was required to document the service line material up to the meter and those records were checked for lead lines. Accounts that were questionable were followed up and verified for material. There are a total of 7,000 service connections. About 3,000 meters were installed between 2006 and present by the City personnel. During meter replacements, only 1 additional lead service line was discovered (91 Baker St.) that had not been documented prior. Additionally, due to the meter replacement project, the majority of water meters installed in the system are lead free.

### Buildings Served by Berea Water System Likely to contain lead solder


Tier 1 sites are single family residences that contain copper pipes with lead solder installed after 1982 and up to 1988 (when lead solder was banned in July 1987.) The City of Berea still has the plumbing permit books from this time period, and the permits were reviewed to find plumbing work permits issued during this time and used to determine the tier 1 sites.

Most of Berea was developed prior to 1988, and therefore copper plumbing with leaded solder was utilized. "Attachment A" shows the population boom after World War II in the City of Berea -almost tripling between 1940 and 1960. Berea reached its peak population in the 1970 census. Attached to this summary is a street listing (Attachment B) of all streets in Berea with date the street was developed. Most streets with no date are original City streets which may have a variety of construction dates from new to old. These streets would have construction before the 1950 standard of copper service line requirements and therefore lead lines could be possible. These areas will continue to be looked at closely to determine if lead pipes are present.

### **New Construction**

Berea has some residential construction after the 1988 no lead standard. Old Reservoir Road (16 SFH), Loriann Drive (20 SFH) and Park Place (29 SFH) are areas developed in 1988 or later. The Sandstone Ridge Development in the upper northwest portion of the City began construction in 2004 and includes 569 SFH (56 planned for future development). Much of the industrial area on West Bagley Road was constructed after it was annexed to the City of Berea and city water and sewer were provided in 1988.
