

The Village of Shawnee


Here in the Village of Shawnee our system was replaced about 2000. The Superior fibers factory is shut down and is full of copper lines. Almost every building in town was constructed around the turn of the century - (1900). From what I have learned in my short time working here, there is a lot of copper and galvanized service lines still feeding the homes and business'. All service lines were replaced with $\frac{3}{4}$ " CTS from the main to the meters.

We went around door to door with our questionairre with very little cooperation. People act like they don't care or they don't want to let us know what type of plumbing is in their homes. Most service lines from the meter's to the houses and business' are either copper or galvanized.
