Dear Sir or Madam,

I am sending the required documentation pertaining to the new and or revised *Lead Mapping in Distribution Systems* guidelines. Included in this packet are the following resources:

- Verification Form for Community Public Water Systems Claiming No Lead Service Lines
- Review Checklist for 6109.121(F) LCR Mapping
- Spreadsheet containing Lead and Copper sampling locations, SMP ID, and Tier Site
- Current site map

At this time, all know watermain lines servicing all the buildings encompassing Wagoner Homes is known to be either 2" or 3" plastic lines. In addition, all service lines connecting the water main line to the individual buildings and lots at the park are believed to be plastic as well. Due to the current medical condition and advanced age of the park owner, Don Wagoner, the following statement is being included, as directed by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA).

"Buildings in Ohio built prior to 1998 or that use plumbing material or solder manufactured before 1998 may have materials with greater than 8% lead and are at a higher risk of contributing lead to the drinking water than materials manufactured after 1998. In addition, buildings built and plumbing materials manufactured after 2014 were required to have less than 0.25% lead by weight and have the lowest risk for contributing lead to the drinking water. It should be noted however that, although prohibited, some use of leaded solder or leaded components may have occurred after the prohibitions became effective."
