Prior to us purchasing the park in 2002, all underground waterlines were replaced with new 2" PVC. All risers & service lines are either galvanized or PEX.

All lines inside the well house are galvanized going to PVC. The line going to the pump in the well is PVC.

In October 2014 we replaced the well pump feed line with white well PVC.

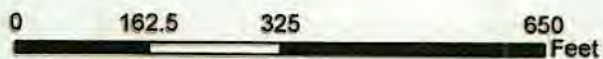
All residents were given a survey to complete to select the materials used in their water system. I have enclosed their responses.

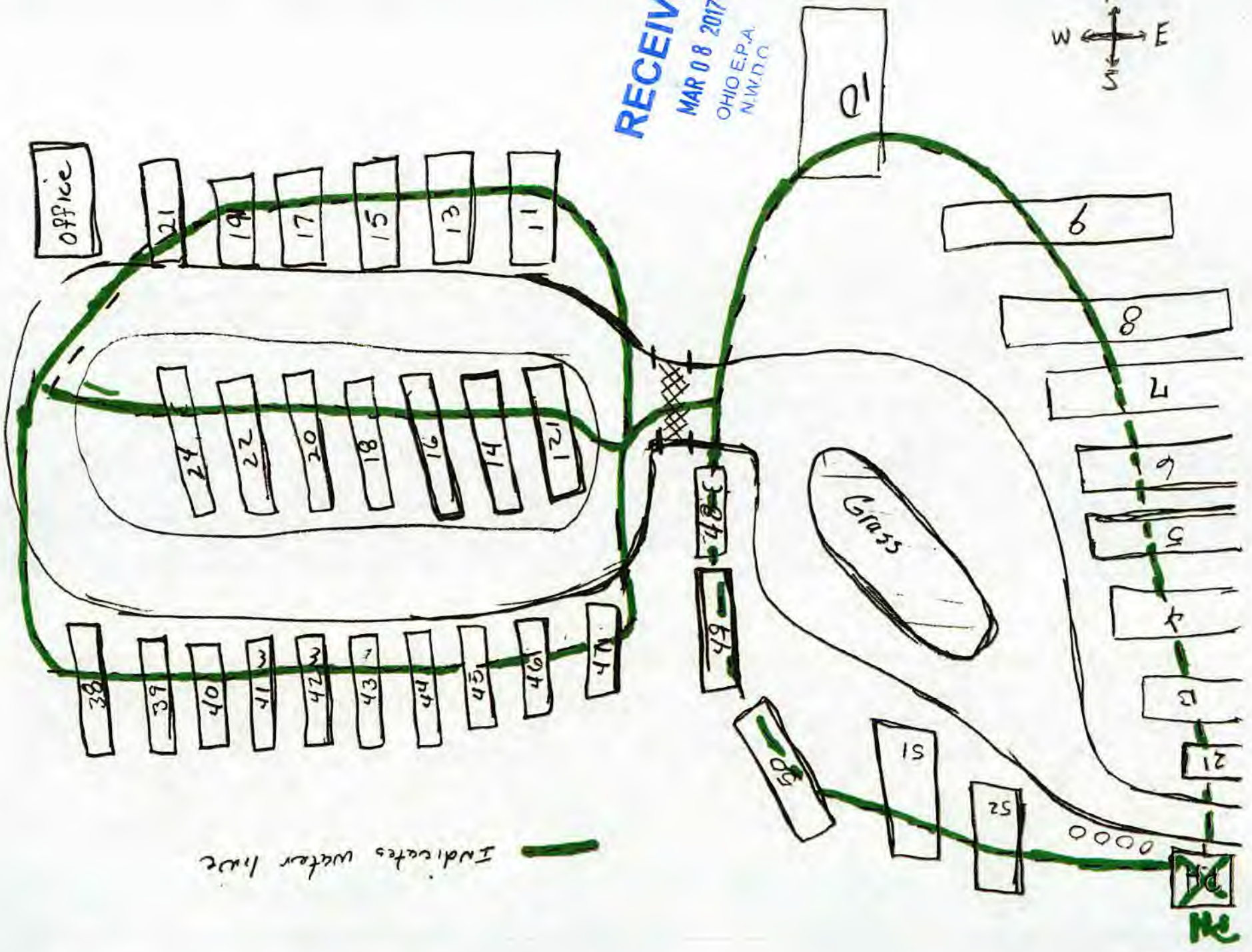

Last evening a few hours after The City of Wapakoneta restored electric to the park (I'm not for sure of all the details, but will update you when I get them) our water pump failed. Rick was on site late last night to assess the situation. He is installing new pump and also lines going to pump with new PVC this morning. I have issued a one call and I am also having our park manager go door to door to notify tenants. Water should be restored by noon and they were informed of boil alert till further notice.
