Buildings in Ohio built prior to 1998 or that use plumbing material or solder manufactured before 1998 may have materials with greater than 8% lead and are at a higher risk of contributing lead to the drinking water than materials manufactured after 1998. In addition, buildings built and plumbing materials manufactured after 2014 were required to have less than 0.25% lead by weight and have the lowest risk for contributing lead to the drinking water. It should be noted however that, although prohibited, some use of leaded solder or leaded components may have occurred after the prohibitions became effective.

Enclosed is the City of Dayton's Distribution Lead Map, for compliance with House Bill 512.

Buildings in Ohio built prior to 1998 or that use plumbing material or solder manufactured before 1998 may have materials with greater than 8% lead and are at a higher risk of contributing lead to the drinking water than materials manufactured after 1998. - -The yellow shaded areas of the map were constructed prior to 1998, and is noted in the legend as lead.
- -The green shaded areas of the map were constructed post 1998, and is noted in the legend as non-lead.
- -The red squares on the map are confirmed Tier I first draw sites.

This data for the map was verified using Count Auditor records, Lead/Copper customer questionnaires, and internal maintenance records.
