NARRATIVE for 2017 LEAD MAPPING

Distribution System Mains: After review of the Village distribution system as-builts, mapping and various other records available to current Village personnel as well as past operational efforts revealing mainline construction materials, the Village doesn't have any leaded molten joint on their water mains.

Service Line Material: The Village does have some known lead service lines from the main up to the building within its distribution system, those locations are used for sampling purposes.

Buildings served by PWS likely to contain lead solder, plumbing or fixtures: The map submitted details by parcel, homes and buildings built within the specified time frames. Those structures built within the timeframes determined to have the potential of lead solder, plumbing or fixtures beyond the service lateral are detailed based on structure age information obtained from the Sandusky County Auditors office.

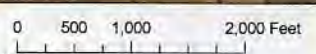
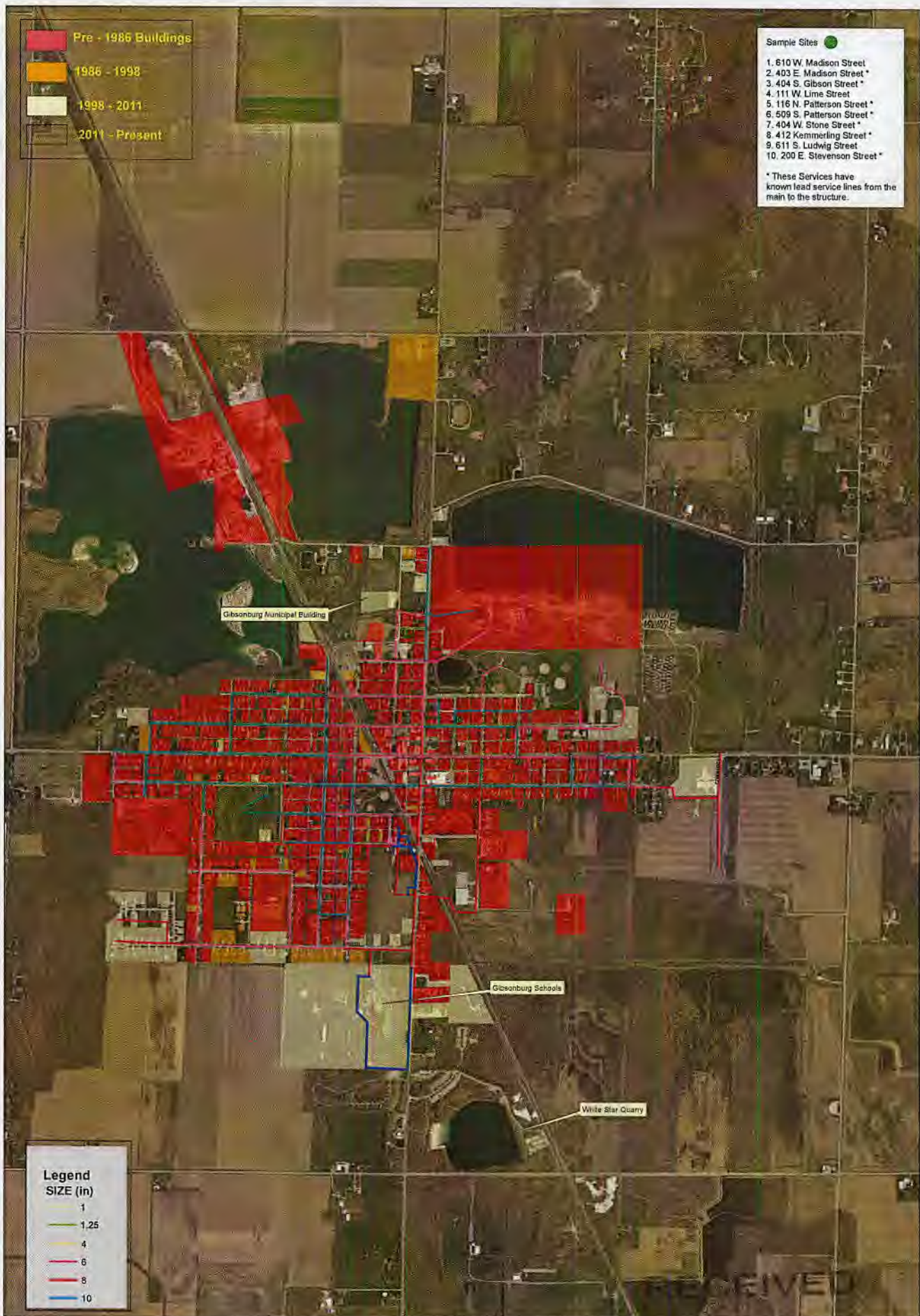
Description of areas of the PWS where susceptible buildings are located: Buildings that may or may not have lead solder, fixtures or plumbing are located in most of the service area of the Village.

History of Lead Sampling: Review of historical data shows that the Village has never been above the Action level for lead and copper sampling.
