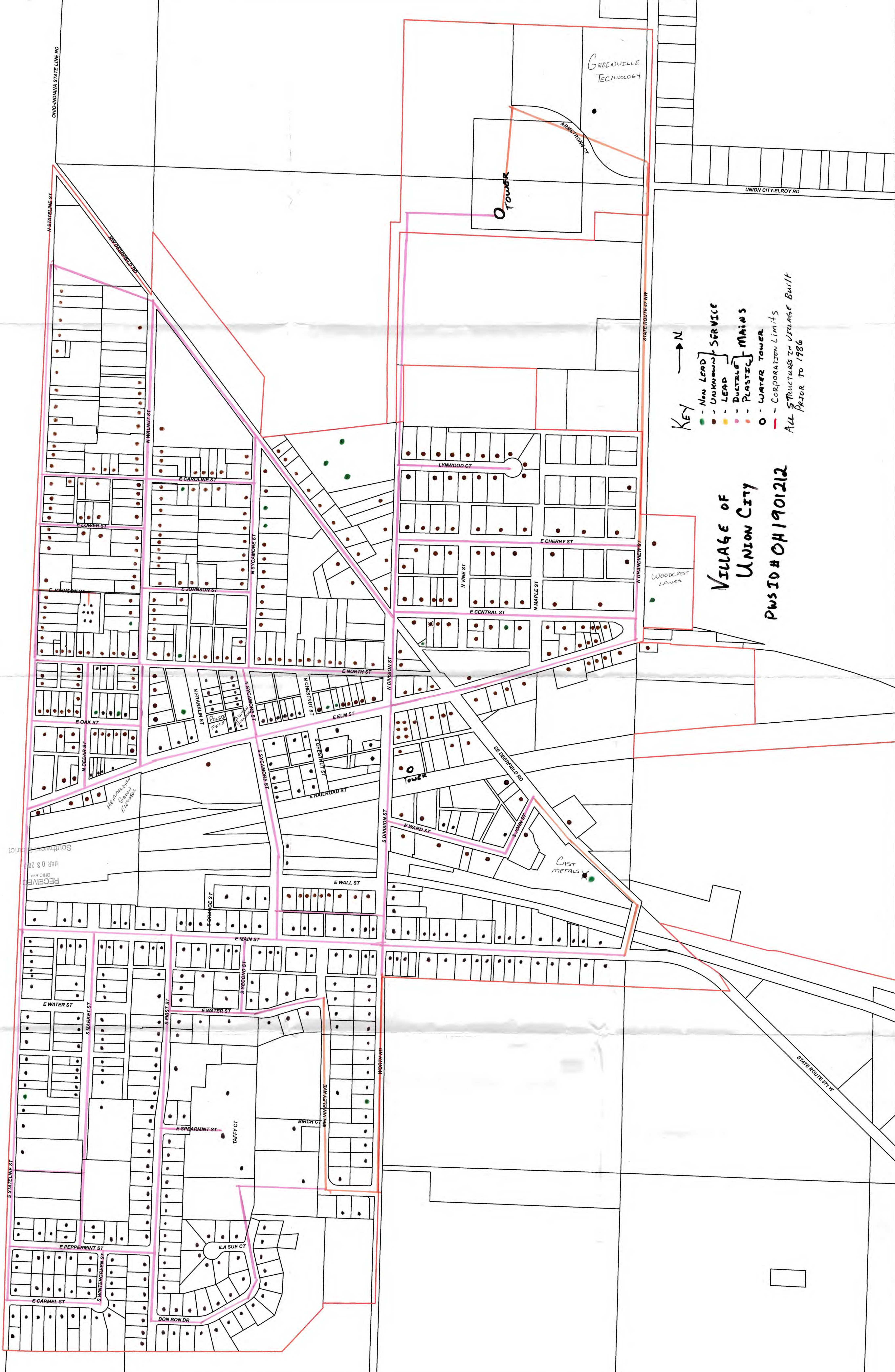

Following is narrative description of documentation of service lines and water mains;

As far as we know Village of Union City has 600 service lines total with 570 active accounts 18 service lines are known to be non-lead lines. The remaining 552 service lines are prior to 1986, which we believe to have copper service lines and inside copper plumbing that consist of copper tubing with lead solder. Because it is practically impossible to determine the lead content of an installed fixture, fitting or pipe, it should be assumed that the manufacture or installation date is the primary indicator of the lead content. Therefore, the characteristics of buildings and piping solder or fixtures would be buildings in Ohio built prior to 1998 or that use plumbing material or solder manufactured before 1998 may have materials with greater than 8% lead and are at a higher risk of contributing lead to the drinking water than materials manufactured after 1998. In addition, buildings built and plumbing materials manufactured after 2014 were required to have less than 0.25% lead by weight and have the lowest risk for contributing lead to the drinking water. it should be noted however that, although prohibited, some use of leaded solder or leaded components may have occurred after the prohibitions became effective.

Union City water mains are all 2 inch, 4 inch, 6 inch, and 8 inch C-900 and Ductile iron.

We believe that Village of Union City do have more lead service lines within the village. As we find these lead service lines we will continue to replace these services with copper or/and CTS plastic tubing and up date our maps as we replace lead service lines.

We believe that all homes in Union City, Ohio where built prior to 1986 which does contain lead lines and/or lead solder.
