This is the lead mapping for the Village of Milan. I have enclosed our SMP location sheet, a copy of the letter that will be sent with every map, the distribution map and the service line map. You will also find a sample of all the residence type of service lines list that I will give to the customer, for example if the residence is at 15 Wilcoxson St., I will give them all the needed paper work plus the page that their address is on and I will highlight their information. Plus, there is a copy of the survey sheet and letter that was sent to the home owner to determine their type of piping. We have been replacing our water mains since 1992, so we don't have a lot of areas that have lead in them. We have replaced all the system water mains in town. VILLAGE OF MILAN PIPE MAPPING

Buildings in Ohio built prior to 1998 or that use plumbing material or solder manufactured before 1998 may have materials with greater than 8% lead and are at a higher risk of contributing lead to the drinking water than materials manufactured after 1998. In addition, buildings built and plumbing materials manufactured after 2014 were required to have less than 0.25% lead by weight and have the lowest risk for contributing lead to the drinking water. It should be noted however that, although prohibited, some use of leaded solder or leaded components may have occurred after the prohibitions became effective.

The Village of Milan has replaced most of our in town system water mains. We started replacing them in 1992. We have repaired most of the water mains outside of town and there appears to be no lead water mains.

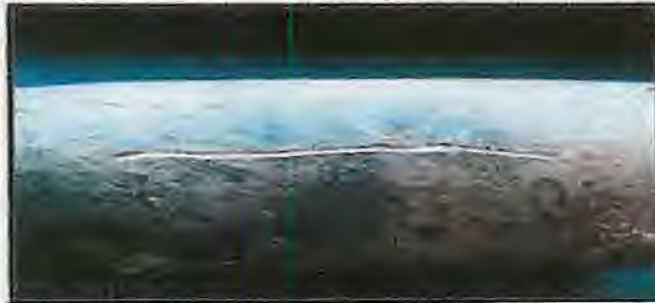

Dear Milan Water Consumer,

The Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A.) is requiring the Village of Milan to have an inventory list of the type of water service line you have entering your home. The Village is sending you this questionnaire to determine if you have copper, plastic, lead or galvanized piping. If you have trouble determining your type of pipe you can do a "scratch test" on the pipe, see illustration below. If you do not feel comfortable doing this test, the Water Department would gladly come to your house to see what kind of piping you have. You can call our office at 419.499.4161 Ext. 8 between the hours of 7:00 AM until 3:30 PM if you have questions, concerns or would like to schedule an appointment for us to come to your house.

How do I know if I have a lead service line?

What do lead service lines look like?



Lead service lines are generally a dull gray color and are very soft. You can identify them easily by carefully scratching with a key. If the pipe is made of lead, the area you've scratched will turn a bright silver color. Do not use a knife or other sharp instrument and take care not to puncture a hole in the pipe.
