This is the explanation of the notes on the mapping for lead.

Over the last 30 years we have been in all the water lines and know that there are no lead lines. All the main lines in town are A/C pipe with gasket joints and about ¼ of the lines have been changed to plastic and all but 6 fire hydrants have been changed out. Also all valves have been changed out but 7 in the last 5 years.

We have meter pits for all residents in the village and we have been in each one of them and know for sure there are no lead services in Hamler. We are also in the process of changing out all meter yokes and valves as we are going to radio read unit. This should be done by the end of March. The yokes will all have backflow units on them.

Buildings in Ohio built prior to 1998 or that use plumbing material or solder manufactured before 1998 may have materials with greater than 8% lead are at a higher risk of contributing lead to the drinking water than materials manufactured after 1998. In addition, buildings built and plumbing materials manufactured after 2014 were required to have less 0.25% lead by weight and have the lowest risk for contributing lead to the drinking water. It should be noted however that, although prohibited, some use of leaded solder or leaded components may have occurred after the prohibitions became effective.
