


VILLAGE OF QUAKER CITY

The Village of Quaker City submitted a form, on or around the 6th of March, 2017, stating that there are no lead service lines within the Village's water distribution system. When taking over as the ORC for the Village on March 31st, 2017 I was ask by the OEPA to research this claim. I began researching this claim of no lead service lines. While I could not prove the claim of no lead services, I could not substantiate the absence of lead services either. The Village made this claim based on a lack of documentation showing that lead services either were present, on non-existent. This claim was made on the memory and information that was passed from operator to operator throughout time (some of which are now deceased). I would ask that the Ohio EPA allow the Village to withdrawal the form and letter stating there are no lead services within the Village of Quaker City's water distribution system.

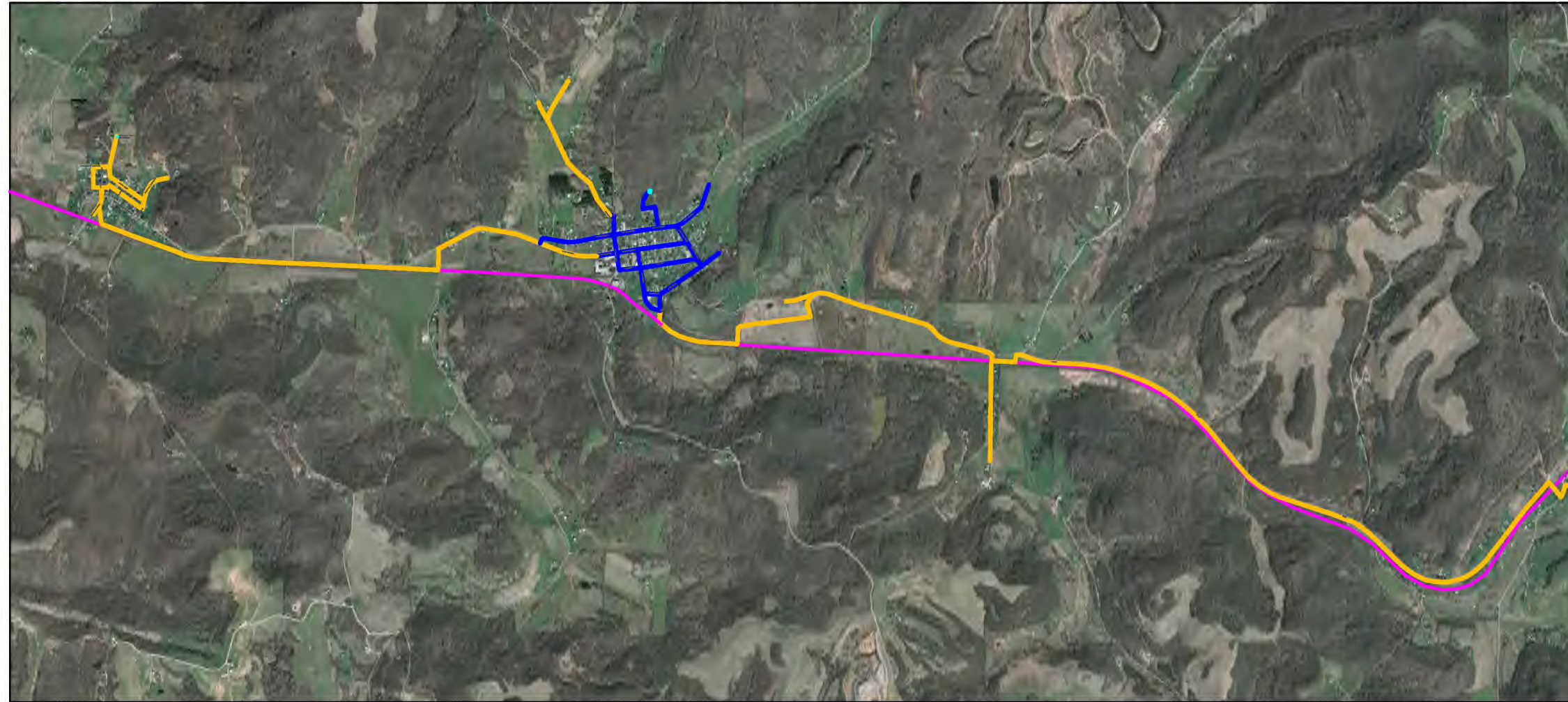

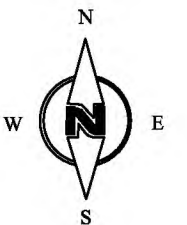

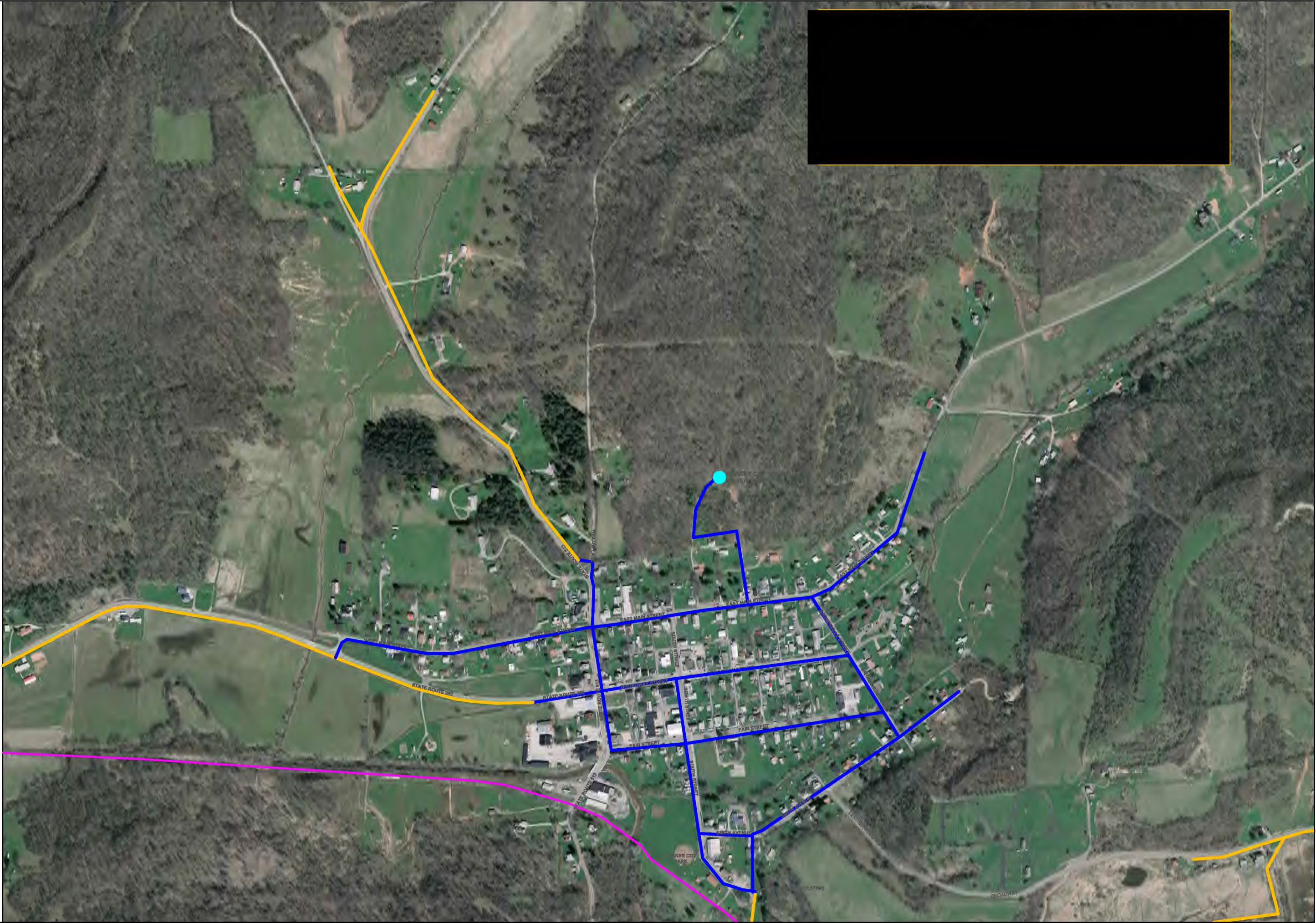
