Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-30-08(D)(2) Approval**

Dear Mr. Pytak:

On October 31, 2017, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northeast District Office (NEDO) received a request, dated October 30, 2017, titled "Request for an Alternative List of Parameters in Accordance with 3745-30-08(D)(2) for Aluminum Smelting & Refining Landfill." The document was submitted in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-30-08(D)(2) by Bowser-Morner, Inc., on behalf of Aluminum Smelting & Refining Landfill (ASR), and requested an alternative analytical parameter list suitable for wastes generated by aluminum manufacturing operations to conduct ground water monitoring activities at the Aluminum Smelting & Refining Landfill (Facility) located at 1601 Brown Road, Ashtabula County, Ohio.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-30-08(D)(2), the owner or operator of a residual or industrial waste landfill may propose an alternate list of parameters to meet the requirements of paragraphs (D)(3) to (D)(6) of this rule. The list of alternate parameters shall be submitted by the owner or operator and approved by the director prior to use. The alternate parameter list shall be indicative of the waste stream(s) deposited at the landfill facility and shall be protective of human health and safety and the environment.

I have reviewed the applicable information and approve the alternate list of parameters for detection ground water monitoring at the Facility. The Facility shall continue monitoring all wells in the monitoring system for the alternate list of parameters in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-30-08, unless otherwise authorized by Ohio EPA.


You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission

within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
