Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(4) Approval**

Dear Mr. Kinsella:

On December 8, 2017, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Southwest District Office (SWDO) received a request, dated December 8, 2017, titled "Alternate Parameter List Request for Low Yield Wells P-22D, P-23D, and P-24D." The document was prepared in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(4) by SCS Engineers, on behalf of Rumpke of Ohio, Inc., and requested an alternate parameter list for low-yield ground water monitoring wells at Rumpke Waste, Inc. Brown County Landfill (Facility) located at 9427 Beyers Road, Georgetown, Ohio.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(4), "the owner or operator may propose, in writing, that an alternative list of any of the Appendix I monitoring parameters be used to meet the requirements of paragraph (D)(5)(c) of this rule for those monitoring wells not screened in the uppermost aquifer system that cannot produce enough water within a 24-hour period to allow for the analysis of all the required parameters. Upon approval by the director or his authorized representative, the owner or operator may use the alternative parameter list."

Ohio EPA reviewed the applicable information and approves the designation of monitoring wells P-22D, P-23D, and P-24D as low-yield monitoring wells, to be sampled using an alternate parameter list as demonstrated in the request, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(4). The Facility shall continue monitoring all other wells in the monitoring system for the parameters listed in Appendix I in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10, unless otherwise authorized by Ohio EPA.

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You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
