Dear Sir or Madam:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-555-10 and the rules adopted thereunder, has reviewed the application for a permit with accompanying detail plans, specifications and/or information (hereinafter referred to as "application") regarding the above-referenced facility. This application has been approved by the Director subject to the conditions of compliance contained in the permit approval enclosed herewith and with all applicable laws, rules, and standards. All construction must be supervised by an engineer or expert qualified in such work. Because the permit approval contains conditions of compliance, I urge you to read it carefully.

You are requested to submit within thirty (30) days of the date of issuance of this Permit to Install, the required permit fee balance of two thousand one hundred dollars and no cents (\$2,500 - \$400.00 application fee = \$2,100.00), payable to **Treasurer, State of Ohio**. Payment of the fee balance within 30 days is a requirement of ORC Sections 3745.11 (Q) and (V). Failure to timely submit the required permit fee will result in an assessment of late penalties.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. 

The above-named entity is hereby issued a permit to install (permit) for the above-described source pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-555-10. Issuance of this permit does not constitute expressed or implied approval or agreement that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with the plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will operate in compliance with applicable state and federal laws, rules, and regulations, and does not constitute expressed or implied assurances that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with those plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will be granted the necessary operating permits and/or licenses. This permit is issued subject to the attached conditions which are hereby incorporated and made a part hereof.

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3734.44, the applicant has exhibited sufficient reliability, expertise, and competency to operate the solid waste facility. This determination is made based upon review of the disclosure statements submitted pursuant to ORC Section 3734.42

PERMIT SUMMARY

This FINAL permit (Permit Number 1365809) authorizes the construction of the Zanesville Transfer Station (Facility) located north of Adamsville Road, Washington Township, Muskingum County, Ohio. MJK Recycling LLC is the owner, permit applicant, and facility operator.

The proposed Facility (approximately 7.6 acres) is located on Parcel #70380102000 (approximately 141.5 acres). The Facility has been designed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-555. The waste handling area is contained within a 120-foot by 85-foot building and includes an elevated tipping floor and a lower semi-trailer loading bay. The Facility will receive, handle, and transfer solid waste and construction and demolition debris (C&DD). Solid waste and (C&DD) will be deposited directly onto the waste handling area, consolidated, and reloaded into transfer trailers for transport to other licensed solid waste disposal facilities. The waste handling area is approximately 10,200 square feet.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached permit.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Director), or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named applicant (permittee) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (solid waste transfer facility).
2. The Facility shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted to Ohio EPA which constitute this permit. There shall be no deviation from the approved permit or permit conditions without the express, written approval of Ohio EPA. Any deviation from the approved plans or the permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of this permit does not constitute an assurance that the Facility will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations. Additional components shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the Facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.
3. Issuance of this permit does not relieve the permittee of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
4. This permit shall apply only to the Facility shown on the plans, specifications, and information submitted as part of PTI Application Number 1365809, received on September 1, 2020, with subsequent revisions received through December 30, 2020.

5. This permit may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-555 applicable to this solid waste transfer facility.
6. The permittee shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the Facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-555.
7. Nothing in this permit shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations except as specified herein. This permit shall not be interpreted to release the permittee from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
8. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except for those excluded from hazardous or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
9. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M. No such asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material may be accepted without first obtaining the necessary permits from Ohio EPA.
10. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of whole or shredded scrap tires or dedicated loads of source-separated yard waste unless the whole or shredded scrap tires or dedicated loads of source-separated yard waste are managed in accordance with OAC Rules 3745-555-650(G)(8) and (G)(10) or are transferred to another state for management in accordance with the laws of that state.
11. Not later than seven days prior to starting any construction authorized under this permit, the permittee shall submit to Ohio EPA, Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Southeast District Office (SEDO) written notification of the anticipated construction start date so that construction of the Facility can be routinely inspected by Ohio EPA, DMWM, SEDO.
12. The permittee shall provide for the following inspections and facility maintenance:
 - a. The permittee shall provide for the daily inspection of the solid waste transfer facility and completion of the Solid Waste Transfer Facility Daily Log of Operations, Form 3. Written results of the inspections, including any corrective measures taken, shall be made available to Ohio EPA, Southeast District Office (SEDO), upon request.
 - b. Surface water control structures, including catch basins, storm sewers, ditches and storm sewer discharge structures shall be inspected at least

monthly for erosion, clogging, or failure and prompt corrective action shall be taken if necessary. Written results of the inspections, including any corrective actions taken, any water quality samples taken, the date, and weather conditions, shall be made available to Ohio EPA, SEDO upon request.

13. Prior to license issuance, the permittee shall submit to Ohio EPA an executed and funded financial assurance instrument which meets the requirements of OAC Rules 3745-503-05 and 3745-503-20 in an amount no less than the closure cost estimate included in the permit application.
14. Prior to license issuance, the permittee is to post signage providing clear instructions for using the facility in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-555-620(C).
15. Prior to license issuance, the permittee shall submit a construction certification establishing that the solid waste transfer facility was constructed in compliance with the approved permit in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-555-500.
16. Pursuant to ORC Sections 3745.11(Q) and (V), payment of the solid waste PTI fee balance, in the amount of two thousand one hundred dollars (\$2,100.00) payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio," shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, Attn: Fiscal Administration, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049. The fee balance shall be submitted within 30 days of the effective date of this permit approval. Failure to timely submit the required permit fee balance will result in assessment of late penalties in accordance with ORC Sections 3745.11(Q) and (V).
