Dear Mr. Thaxton:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) is in receipt of a letter dated June 30, 2021, in which Rumpke Waste, Inc. and Kilbarger Construction, Inc. requested approval to transfer the 2021 solid waste facility license for Meigs County Transfer Station municipal solid waste transfer facility. The license is currently issued to Kilbarger Construction, Inc. and is proposed to be transferred to Rumpke Waste, Inc. On August 9, 2021, Rumpke Waste, Inc. submitted a complete license application containing all required information. After reviewing this information, Ohio EPA has determined that none of the reasons for denial specified in OAC Rule 3745-501-35 apply to Meigs County Transfer Station.

Rumpke Waste, Inc. is required to establish and maintain financial assurance in accordance with OAC Rules 3745-501-35 before the license transfer is approved. Ohio EPA is in receipt of documentation from Rumpke Waste, Inc. that satisfies the financial assurance requirements.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-501-35, Ohio EPA hereby approves the transfer of the solid waste facility license from Kilbarger Construction, Inc. to Rumpke Waste, Inc. For the transfer to be effective, the Meigs County Health Department must also approve the transfer of the license to Rumpke Waste, Inc.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the


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fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
