Dear Mr. Rogatto:

Thank you for accompanying me during Ohio EPA's August 26, 2021, inspection of Avon Lake Power Plant, in Avon Lake, Ohio. I inspected the facility to determine its compliance with Ohio's Air Pollution Control laws as found in Chapter 3704 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and regulations found in Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and the terms and conditions of the Title V operating permit P0127805. The inspection included a virtual site visit (VSV) which included a Microsoft Teams discussion of facility operations, a virtual tour of operating emission units, and a review of company operations and written documentation. I found no violations of Ohio's Air Pollution Control laws, regulations or permit requirements during this inspection.

The recommendations set out below are NOT orders and are offered by Ohio EPA NEDO DAPC in an effort to provide compliance assistance to your facility.

- Regarding emissions unit F001, F002, and P901, the facility is required to summarize the total number of days when control measures were implemented and the total number of days where snow and/or ice cover or precipitation were sufficient to not require the control measures. While the facility has this information, it is not summarized on a quarterly basis. The facility is advised to immediately begin summarizing this information as required.

Please be advised that this notice of compliance is only associated with those areas of the operations that were inspected or documentation reviewed and does not constitute a waiver of potential violations not discovered.
